EXUMAS 7 DAY ITINERARY

NASSAU – NASSAU



The Bahamas are an archipelago of about 700 islands and 2,400 uninhabited islets and cays lying 50 mi off the east coast of Florida. They extend for about 760 mi (1,223 km). Only about 30 of the islands are inhabited; the most important is New Providence (80 sq mi; 207 sq km), on which the capital, Nassau, is situated. Other islands include Grand Bahama, Abaco, Eleuthera, Andros, Cat Island, and San Salvador (or Watling's Island).



DAY 1.

Fly into Nassau Bahamas on a 35min flight from South Florida, Your Private Yacht Captain will meet you at the Airport and Escort you and your friends/family to the Yacht, which is docked at the World Famous Albany Resort. The Chef will have welcome cocktails and snacks of your choice. The rest of the day can be spent unwinding on board, playing golf, or time spent at the world-renowned spa.



Dinner can either be onboard the yacht or the crew will make reservations at the “Footprints” Resort restaurant



DAY 2.

After a Breakfast Aboard the Captain will move the yacht across the Exuma banks to the Island of Highborne Cay. Beautiful beaches, a walk around the Marina or a Bike ride to the Southern Tip of the Island to the freshwater spring, or visit the iguanas on nearby Allen's Cay. The Evening can either be spent at anchor off the beach or in the Marina.



DAY 3.

A gentle cruise down to Shroud Cay and into the Exuma Land & Sea Park. Either this trip can be done cruising down on the banks or for those interested in Fishing the run down in Exuma Sound to Wax Cay cut can be quite rewarding.



DAY 4.

Set off for Waderick Wells where the water is every shade of Blue. The trails and walks over the island are a must with a visit to the Park office and the Whale bones on the beach.



DAY 5.

Cruise down to Staniel Cay with a stop for snorkeling at Halls Pond (Johnny Depps Private Island) Anchor at Big Major's Bay where watersports and visiting the Pigs on the Beach is the call for the Afternoon. Evening cocktails and maybe dinner ashore at the Staniel Cay Yacht Club.





DAY 6.

Awake to another adventurous day with Swimming/Snorkeling into Thunderball Cay where the light dances inside the cave and the luminescence through the grotto hole is breathtaking. The cave was filmed in the James Bond 007 movie "Thunderball". Your Captain will lift the anchor and head up to Compass Cay to spend the afternoon feeding and "swimming" (for the brave) with the resident Sharks. Choose to stay in the Marina and enjoy a tantalizing Dinner prepared by your Chef.



DAY 7.

Cruise back over the Bahama Banks to Atlantis Marina & Resort. Spend the afternoon exploring the waterpark and Aquarium. Dinner ashore at one of the numerous restaurants and then try your hand at Blackjack or Roulette.



DAY 8.
